

Certificate of Right of Burial

IN THE

FOOTSCRAY CEMETERY.

ON the application of *Joseph Craus*
 and upon payment of the sum of *Two pounds 4s.*
 which is hereby acknowledged to have been received, the Trustees of the Footscray Cemetery
 in terms of and as authorised by the Cemeteries Statute, 1864, have agreed to grant, and do
 hereby grant unto the said *Joseph Craus*
of Garraville permission to dig or make a grave or vault on that piece of
 ground *eight* feet long by *eight* feet broad, lying within the
 portion of the said Cemetery appropriated for

burials, and marked Compartment *B* Line No. *2* Grave No. *55*
 on the map or plan of the said Cemetery, kept by the said Trustees, with permission to erect
 or place on the said piece of ground a monument or tombstone, on payment of such charges
 as may from time to time be established. And it is hereby declared that the
 said *Joseph Craus* shall
 be entitled to have, maintain, and keep up such vault, monument or tombstone according
 to the terms of this permission, to and for the sole and separate use of the said
Joseph Craus and *his*
 representatives for ever; provided always and it is hereby declared that this grant is made
 subject to the terms and conditions following, viz.:

1st.—That the said piece of ground shall be kept and used by the said
Joseph Craus *his* heirs and near relations solely as a burying place,
 and that no other use shall be made thereof.

2nd.—That no enclosing wall, fence, building, monument or tombstone shall be
 erected or placed on said piece of ground until a plan thereof shall have been exhibited to
 the said Trustees, and their authority given for the erection thereof.

3rd.—That the said grave or vault, and the said wall, fence, building, monument
 or tombstone, shall be maintained and kept by the said *Joseph Craus*
 and *his* representatives in proper repair to the satisfaction of the said Trustees.

4th.—That the said *Joseph Craus* and *his*
 representatives shall, in the use of the said piece of ground and access thereto, be subject in
 every respect to such rules and regulations as the Trustees of the said Cemetery may from
 time to time make, and shall not be entitled to exercise the right to bury or inter therein
 except on payment of such charges as shall from time to time be established by the said
 Trustees.
